

Article I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be the "Slovenian Irish Association Deteljica," hereinafter referred to as "Deteljica."

Section 2: Deteljica is established with the purpose of promoting cultural exchange, friendship, and cooperation between the people of Slovenia and Ireland. The association aims to create an environment that fosters understanding, mutual respect, and unity among its members.

Article II: Leadership and Officers

Section 1: The leadership of Deteljica shall consist of a President, a Vice President, and a Secretary.

Section 2: The President shall be Ines Zdešar.

Section 3: The Vice President shall be Eva Veber.

Section 4: The Secretary shall be Spela Petohleb.

Article III: Duties and Responsibilities

Section 1: The President shall:

- Provide overall leadership and direction to the association.
- Preside over meetings and ensure their proper conduct.
- Represent Deteljica in external matters and official events.
- Oversee the implementation of the association's goals and objectives.

Section 2: The Vice President shall:

- Assist the President in their duties and responsibilities.
- Assume the role of the President in their absence or incapacity.
- Collaborate with other officers to organize events and activities.

Section 3: The Secretary shall:

- Keep accurate records of meetings, decisions, and activities.
- Manage communication with members and external parties.
- Assist in organizing events, workshops, and initiatives.

Article IV: Membership

Section 1: Deteljica shall be open to individuals who share an interest in Slovenian and Irish cultures, regardless of nationality or background.

Section 2: Members shall adhere to the principles and objectives of Deteljica as outlined in this Constitution.

Article V: Meetings

Section 1: Regular meetings of Deteljica shall be held to discuss and plan activities, events, and initiatives.

Section 2: The President, in consultation with other officers, shall determine the schedule of meetings and notify members in advance.

Article VI: Funding and Support

Section 1: Deteljica is co-funded by the "Urad Republike Slovenije za Slovence v Zamejstvu in Po Sveto," the Office of the Republic of Slovenia for Slovenians Abroad.

Article VII: Amendments

Section 1: Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed by any member and shall be presented at a regular meeting.

Section 2: A two-thirds majority vote of the members present shall be required to approve amendments.

Article VIII: Dissolution

Section 1: In the event of the dissolution of Deteljica, its assets shall be distributed in a manner consistent with its purpose and in accordance with applicable laws.

Article IX: Ratification

Section 1: This Constitution shall be ratified by a majority vote of the members present at a general meeting.

Section 2: This Constitution shall take effect immediately upon ratification.
